Since Argentina's record-breaking 2001 debt default, the Argentine government has worked to convince the international community that they were justified in their actions. Argentine President Cristina Kirchner has even denied her country's ability to repay these funds, with \$3.8 billion owed to U.S. creditors and taxpayers, while \$48 billion sits in Argentina's Central Bank.

President Kirchner has refused to honor over 117 U.S. court judgments against her country requiring her pay back U.S. lenders. Congress should encourage Argentina to repay its outstanding debts to the U.S. by supporting H.R. 2493.
